"I got to stay up late and I got to sleep in."



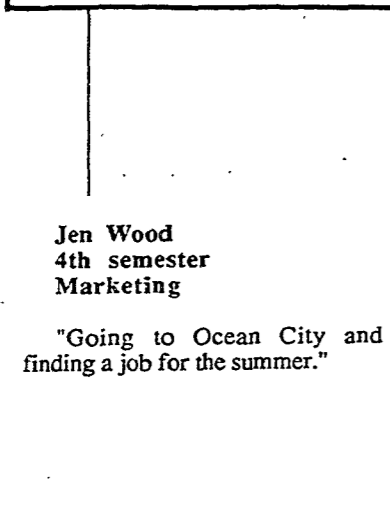

"I spent a lot of money shopping."



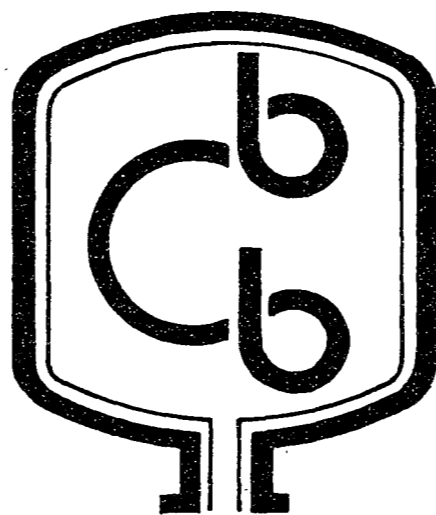
