Liberal Arts Faculty Increases

Three new faculty members have been appointed to the Division of Humanities, Social Sciences and Education.

Dr. George D. Wolf, Division Head, today announced the appointment of Richard I. Ammon, Jr. as Instructor in Humanities and Education; Michael L. Barton, Instructor in Social Science; and Lemuel David Molovinsky, Instructor in American Studies.

Ammon holds a bachelor of science degree in Elementary Education from Penn State and a master of education degree from Temple University. He has taught in the Newtown, Lock Haven and Camden, Delaware, school systems and also served as assistant professor of Education at Jersey City State College. A candidate for a doctorate in education at Penn State, Ammon is a member of Kappa Phi Kappa, honorary education fraternity; Phi Mu Alpha, honorary music fraternity; and Blue Key and Parmi Nous, men's honorary societies.

A native of Nebraska, Barton joins Penn State's faculty after having spent two years conducting research under a United States Public Health Service grant. He graduated in 1965 from the University of Nebraska with a bachelor of science degree and holds master's degrees from the University of Nebraska and the University of Pennsylvania. Currently a Ph.D. candidate at the University of Pennsylvania, Barton is a member of the American Studies Association, the Organization of American Historians and the American Anthropological Association. He is married to the former Jane Warnholz who is a first year medical student at the Medical College of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia.

Molovinsky comes to the Middletown campus after having served five years as a graduate assistant at Temple University. He has a bachelor of science and master of arts degree in history from Temple. He is a member of the education committee of The Partners of the Americas, Penna. - Bahia.
