Ferguson Appointed Grad Program Chief

Dr. Francis Ferguson, Professor of Environmental Design at Capitol Campus has been named Chairman of the Regional Planning Program. His promotion was announced last week by Dr. Robert E. McDermott, Provost.

An architect and planning consultant, Dr. Ferguson joined the Capitol Campus faculty in the fall of 1971 after serving as Associate Professor of Urban Planning in the School of Architecture at Columbia University. While at the campus, Dr. Ferguson has concentrated on developing the computer graphics and design capability within the Regional Planning Program.

After obtaining his architecture degree from the University of Notre Dame, Dr. Ferguson did graduate work at Harvard and Columbia Universities, receiving his Master of Science and Doctor Philosophy degrees in Urban Planning from the latter institution.

He practiced architecture and planning in New York and Paris prior to becoming a member of the faculty at Columbia in 1964. While there, Dr. Ferguson received the William Kinne Fellows Memorial Fellowship and spent the 1962-63 academic

year studying in Europe. Also he is the recipient of a postdoctoral grant from the National Endowment for the Arts for work on planning and design theory.

Dr. Ferguson's major work to date is a United Nations sponsored development plan for New Providence Island and the City of Nassau in the Bahamas which he prepared with the late Paul Lester Wiener under the Auspices of Columbia's Institute of Urban Environment. He also served as a senior research associate of that institute.

He is co-author of the "East River Renewal Study," which involved the design of the area bordering the East River immediately across from the United Nations in New York City.

Dr. Ferguson is a licensed architect in New York and Pennsylvania and is a member of the American Institute of Architects as well as the Society of Architectural Historians, The Architectural League of New York, Environmental Design Research Association, Association of Collegiate Schools of Architecture, the American Institute of Planners and the American Society of Planning Officials.

While serving with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in France from 1956 to 1958, he was cited for the design of facilities for the selection ceremony of the Unknown Soldier of World War II at the American Cemetery and Memorial, Epinal, France.

Dr. Ferguson is married and the father of three children and lives in Maytown, Lancaster County.

University Scholarships (for the 1973-74 Academic Year)

ALL STUDENTS WHO DESIRE TO BE CONSIDERED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY MUST COMPLETE A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND MUST HAVE THEIR PARENTS COMPLETE A PARENTS' CONFIDENTIAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT. THESE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED TO STUDENTS WHO:

1. GIVE EVIDENCE OF SUPERIOR ACADEMIC ATTAINMENT (USUALLY WITH A CUMULATIVE GRADE AVERAGE OF 3.00 OR BETTER).

2. HAVE FINANCIAL NEED AS VERIFIED BY THE PARENTS' CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENT.

3. ARE ENROLLED IN CERTAIN FIELDS OF STUDY, OR HAVE THE CLASS STANDING SPECIFIED BY THE DONORS.

THESE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED BY SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEES IN COLLEGES OF AGRICULTURE, ARTS AND ARCHITECTURE, BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION, EARTH AND MINERAL SCIENCES, EDUCATION, ENGINEERING, HUMAN DEVELOPMENT, LIBERAL ARTS, HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND THE UNIVERSITY SENATE.

ALL SCHOLARSHIPS VARY WIDELY IN AMOUNT. SOME ARE ONE TIME AWARDS AND SOME ARE RENEWABLE FOR SUBSEQUENT YEARS. ALL STUDENTS WHO SEEK TO QUALIFY FOR THE FIRST TIME OR THOSE WHO DESIRE TO HAVE THEIR CURRENT SCHOLARSHIPS RENEWED MUST REAPPLY ANNUALLY.

A NEW APPLICATION AND A NEW PARENTS' CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENT ARE REQUIRED EACH YEAR IN ORDER TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES WITH THE MOST RECENT ACADEMIC FINANCIAL INFORMATION ABOUT ALL OF THE CANDIDATES. APPLICATIONS AND CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENTS

CANDIDATES MAY OBTAIN APPLICATION AND PARENTS' CONFIDENTIAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT FORMS FROM THE OFFICE OF STUDENT AID, 121 GRANGE BUILDING, OR FROM THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE, E-106. COMPLETED APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE RETURNED TO THE OFFICE FROM WHICH THEY HAVE BEEN OBTAINED. COMPLETED PARENTS' CONFIDENTIAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS MUST BE

FORWARDED TO THE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP SERVICE FOR ANALYSIS. DEADLINES

APPLICATIONS AND CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENTS ARE AVAILABLE AT ALL CAMPUSES AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1972 AND MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED BEFORE FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 1973 TO INSURE PROPER CONSIDERATION BY ALL SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEES. UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT GOVERNMENT GRANTS

EACH YEAR THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT GOVERNMENT AWARDS A NUMBER OF GRANTS TO NEEDY STUDENTS WHO HAVE MAINTAINED A CUMULATIVE GRADE AVERAGE OF 2.5 OR BETTER AND HAVE MADE IMPORTANT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY THROUGH CAMPUS STUDENT ACTIVITIES. STUDENTS DESIRING TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THESE GRANTS SHOULD FOLLOW THE SAME APPLICATION PROCEDURE AS OUTLINED ABOVE FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS.

NOTIFICATION OF AWARD SINCE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEES MEET AND CONCLUDE THEIR DELIBERATIONS AT DIFFERENT TIMES, THEY USUALLY MAIL THEIR

AWARD LETTERS VARIOUSLY BETWEEN MAY 1 AND JULY 15. AN APPLICANT WHO DOES NOT RECEIVE A LETTER OF AWARD DURING THIS PERIOD SHOULD ASSUME THAT HE/SHE HAS NOT BEEN SELECTED FOR A SCHOLARSHIP.

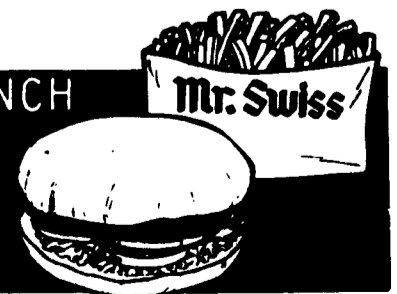

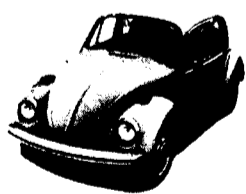
