In an effort to conserve energy during the present fuel crises, the following building hours will be strictly adhered to

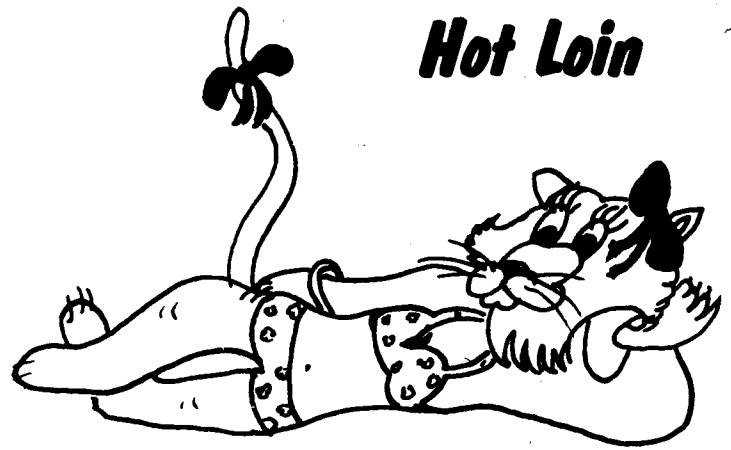
until further notice:

The gym will not be opened on a scheduled basis during the 55° setting, including weekends. The key to the gym will be available for check-out as before, but you should remember to dress a bit warmer.

Recreation/Athletics Building: The temperature setting of 62° for the Rec/Ath Building will be Mondays thru Thursdays from 1:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M., Fridays from 1:00 to 5:00 P.M., Saturdays & Sundays from 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. All other times the setting will be 55° - so remember to dress accordingly.

The hot temperature for both buildings will be reduced to 100° - it would be wise to limit showers to a minimum.

may be. Well, what else can I say, except that's it and I'll see you in Vendorville.

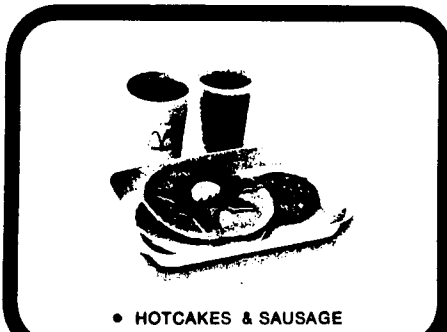

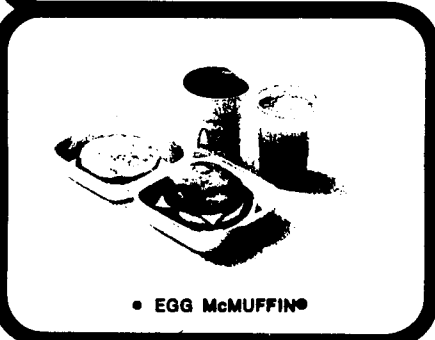
