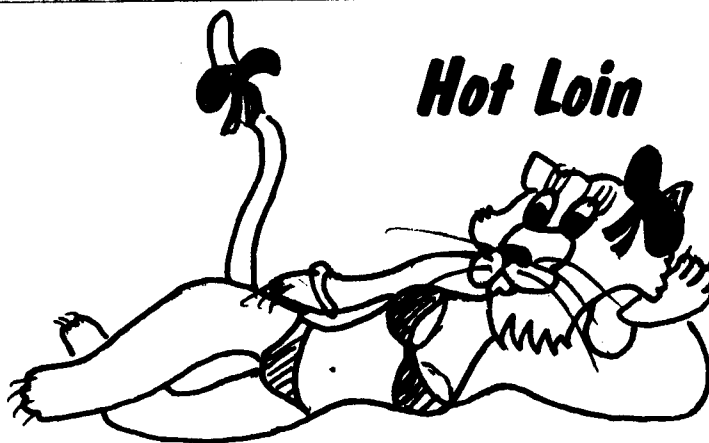




Since lawnmowers are heavy, you might be better off bringing a few sheep in order to see more of this scintillating young lady and five others at Casino Night.

Caryl Kline and Jean Lewis will be guest speakers at a conference entitled "Greater Re-entry Opportunities for Women" -GROW- to be held at the Student Center Sat., April 16 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Caryl Kline, the director of continuing education at the University of Pittsburgh who was recently nominated Sec-

retary of Education by Governor Milton Shapp, and Jean Lewis, assistant Administrator of A.I.D., Washington, D.C., will share their experience and perspectives concerning career opportunities for women.

Kline, also a member of the Pittsburgh City Planning Commission, the board of directors of the Pennsylvania State Colleges and University, the

Psychological Services of Pittsburgh, and the Home Mortgage Opportunity Committee of Pittsburgh, is a prominent speaker for women's programs and has served as a special ambassador to Sierra Leone.

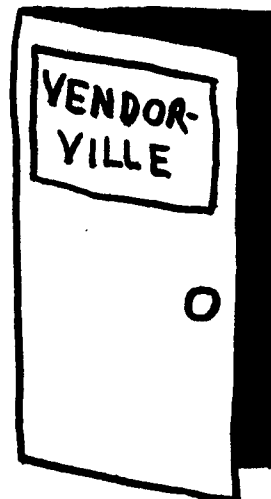
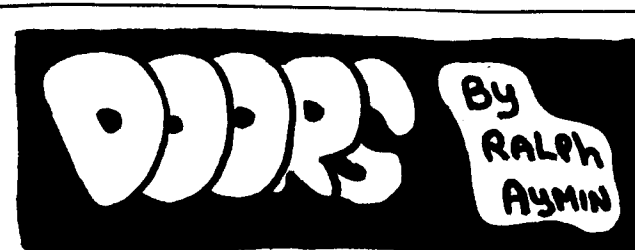
Jean Lewis is presently assistant administrator for Legislative Affairs at the Agency for International Development (A.I.D.). She has served as a staff assistant to Senator John F. Kennedy and has been a White House staff person during the Kennedy and Johnson administrations. Most recently she has received the Superior Honors Award from the Agency for International Development.
