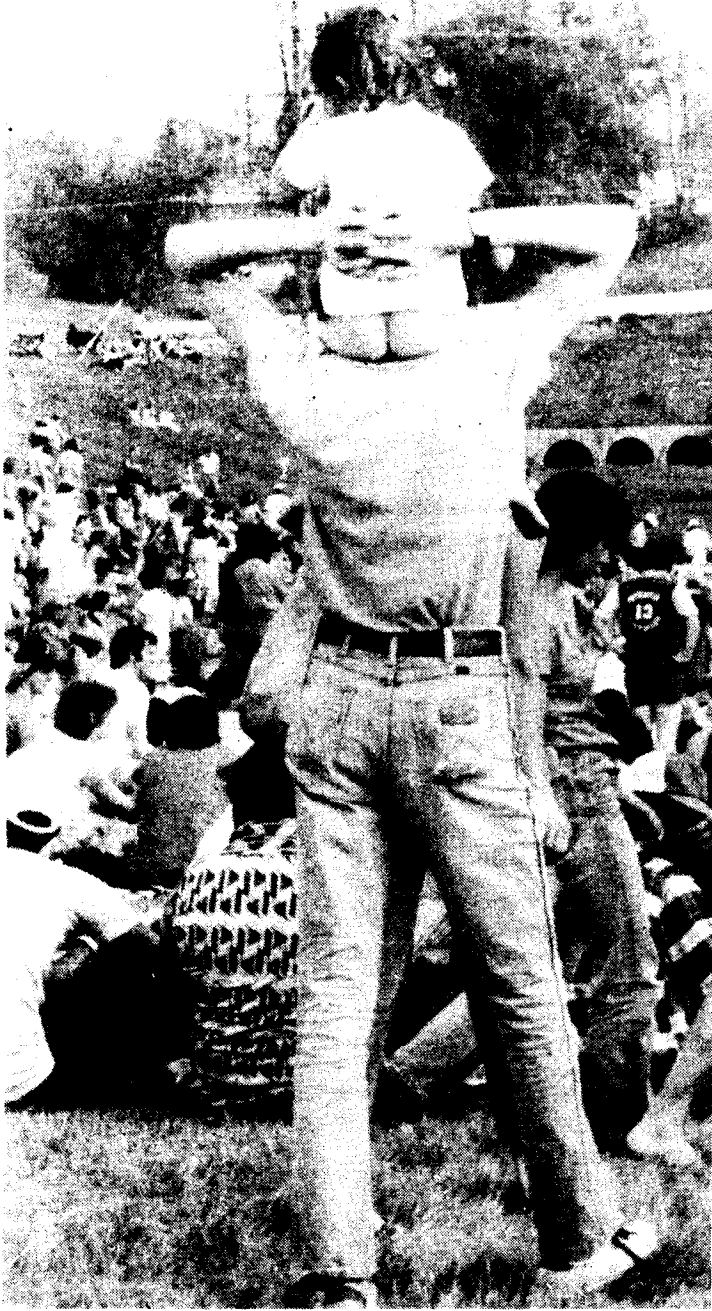

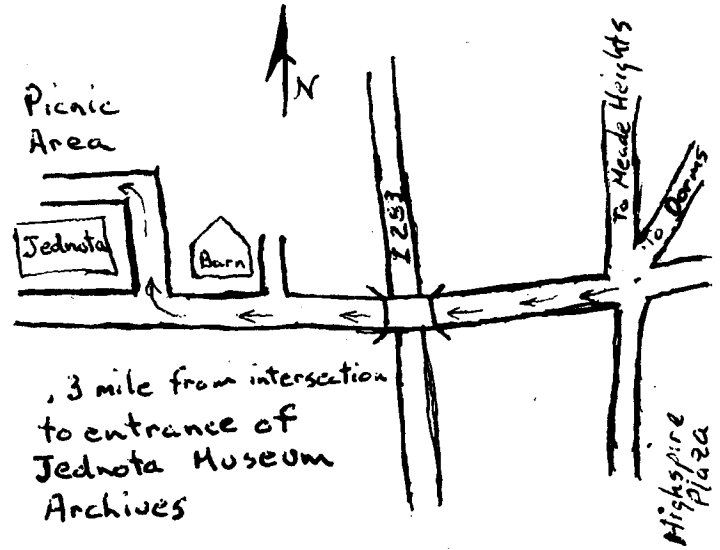


When 'em-bare-assed, cheeks turn red.

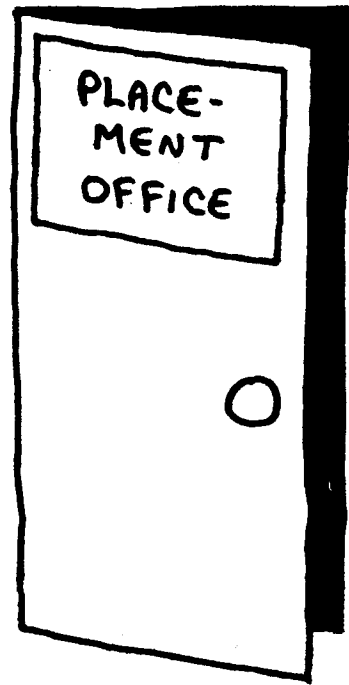
