#### \*Financial Aid

Those veterans who are full-time undergrads and residents of PA should have applied for the Penn. Higher Education Assistance Agency grant.

This grant gives veterans special financial consideration and can cover up to 80 per cent of tuition costs. Those who have not applied for this grant should contact either the Financial Aid Office or the Vet. Affairs Office.

#### \*Tutorial Assistance

If you find that you are having academic difficulties with your courses, the VA does have a tutorial

assistance program to assist you. The VA will pay you up to \$69 per month for a maximum of \$828 to allow you to gain help through a tutor. For further info contact the VA office

### Counseling Center offers classes

Beginning on Wed., Oct. 3, 1979 from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. and continuing on four consecutive Wednesdays (through Oct. 24, 1979) the Counseling Center will offer a Study Effectiveness Training course for interested students at Capitol Campus.

Areas to be covered include, studying for exams, anxiety over tests, taking better notes, preparing term and research papers, managing time effectively, studying effectively, as well as other topics of interest to students. Participants will have the chance to work individually as well as in groups on problems of concern.

Marian Krieger, Counseling Center Coordinator and Ed Beck, Counselor, will be the workshop staff. Materials and references will be distributed during the sessions.

There is **no charge** to students for these workshops, but pre-registration prior to Mon.,Oct. 1, 1979 is requested.

Students may pre-register by stopping by the center during regular office hours, 8 a.m. to noon and 1 to 5 p.m., Mon. through Fri. as well as 5:30 to 8 p.m. Mon. and Thur. evenings.

This program is the first in the "Directions 1979-1980 Series" offered by the Counseling Center.
