

Faculty Committees (continued)

Committee on Student Affairs

Membership: Six members of the full-time teaching faculty, the Dean of Student Affairs (ex-officio), the President of Student Government Association, and two additional full-time undergraduate students selected by the Student Government Association.

The committee shall be concerned with policies involving the academic aspects of student life on the campus and shall present proposals to the Faculty Council for consideration; shall be the principal agency of the Faculty Organization for providing appropriate representation of student opinion on academic matters to the Faculty Organization and shall be the point of entry for student proposals; maintain liaison with the elected officers of the students as appropriately organized and with the Office of Student Affairs; maintain awareness of current trends and long-range studies in student affairs.

Campus Beautification Committee (ad hoc)

The committee's main objective is to create a more attractive and invitational appearance of the campus.

Note: The committees meet on an average of 5 to 6 times per academic year (fall through spring term).

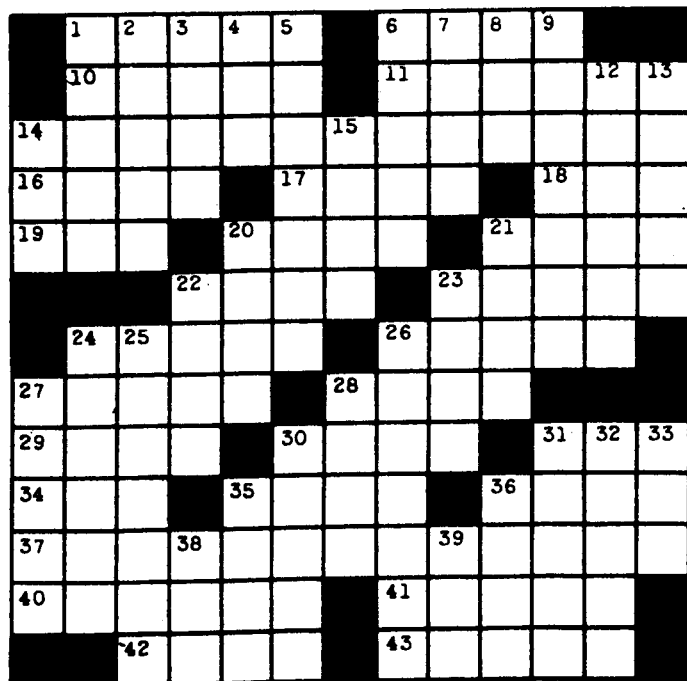
