"What is most remarkable about Chapter Two is the way in which Simon has Characterized George Schneider so clearly that his loss and eventual recovery become symbolic of universal

the fact fully, but do not cling to it self-pityingly nor with guilt. Instead go on to Chapter Two with complete acceptance of and openness to life."


