Some schools go as far as to offer extended parking facilities and a few, like HACC, maintain a child play center for the many parents who commute for classes and need the convenience of a short-term babysitter. Ebersole said the programs that the all-commuter campus offers have to consider the problems of "the real world" because "everyone here is immersed in the real world."

Here at Capitol, a publication called "For Commuters Only" is issued twice each semester to "give commuters information they may not pick up elsewhere," according to Dave Doaty, coordinator for student services. A brown bag lunch series for commuter students has not had a large

turn out, said Doaty, but he said the school is taking steps to make a commuter's experience here more enjoyable.

Doaty said the cultural affairs program here offers both noon and evening events and that there are "a number of offices" open in the evening for convenience.

In addition, Doaty said he and student activities coordinator Jennifer Krohn will be available in the Lion's Den on Tuesday and Wednesday from 5:30 to 7:30 to discuss the special needs and concerns of the commuter student. Doaty said he hoped many students would come and indicate how the school can help meet their needs as commuters.

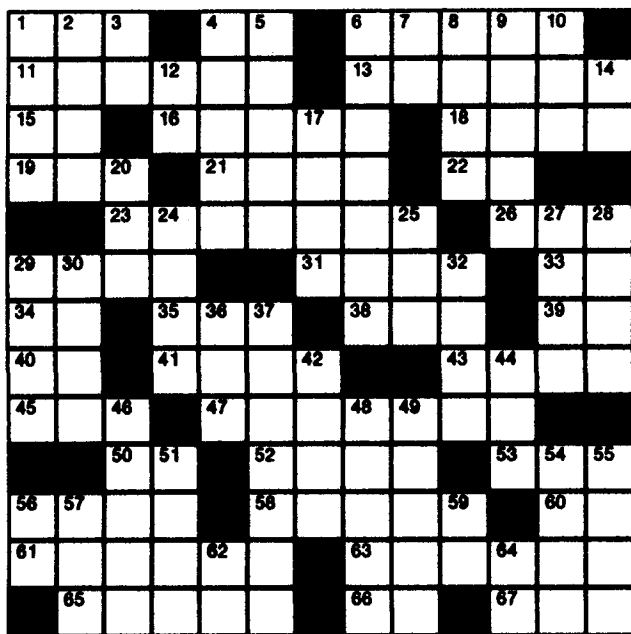
