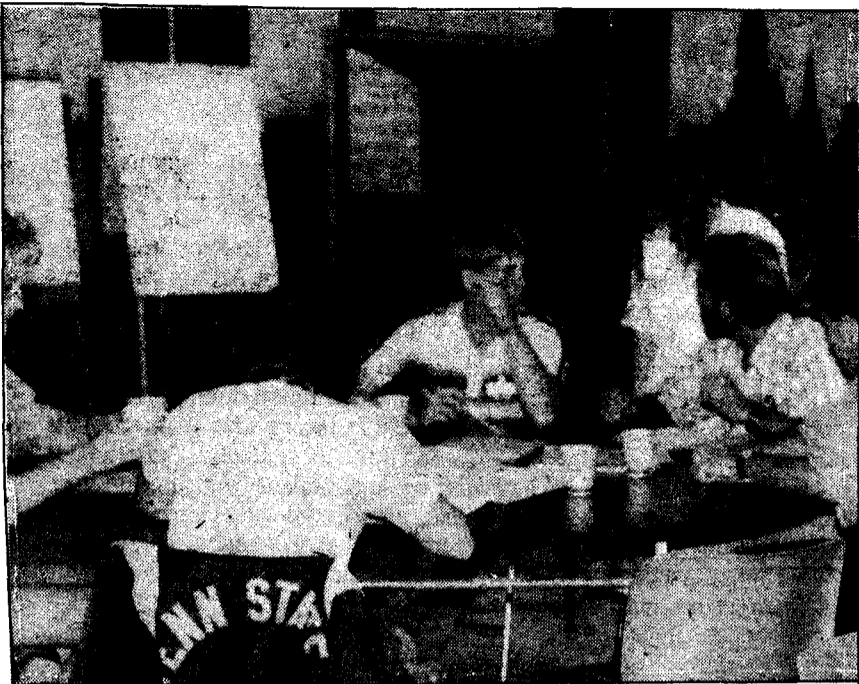

## Student Leadership Conference Held at Capital

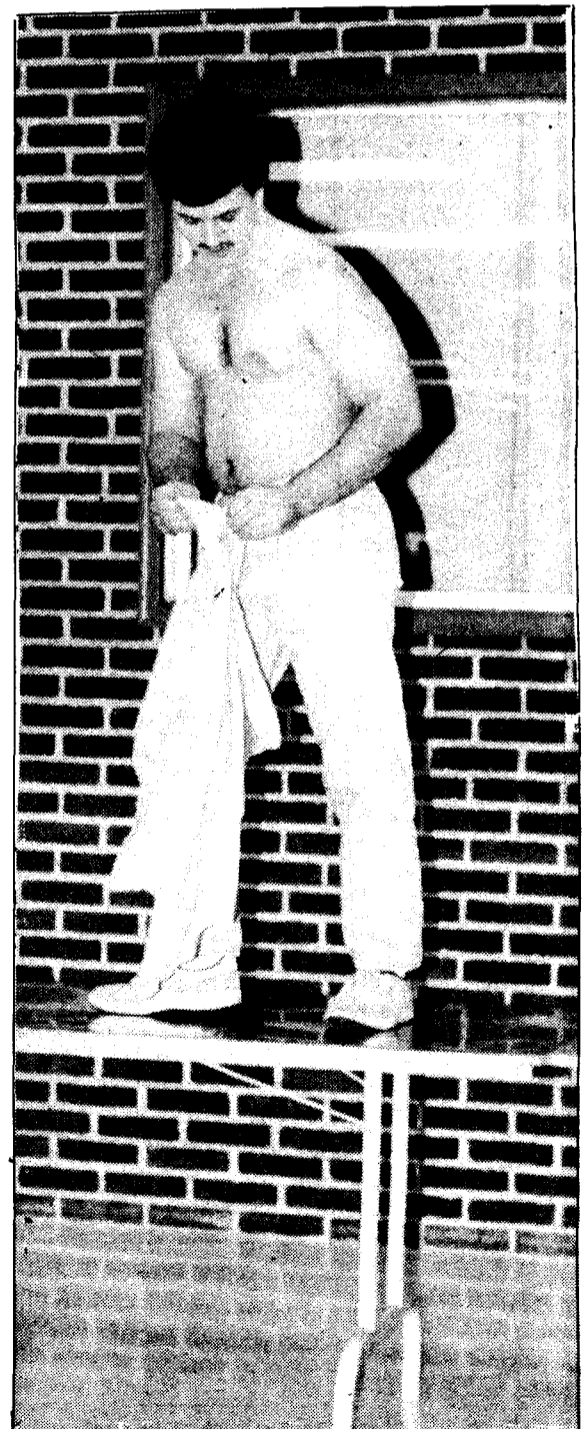
