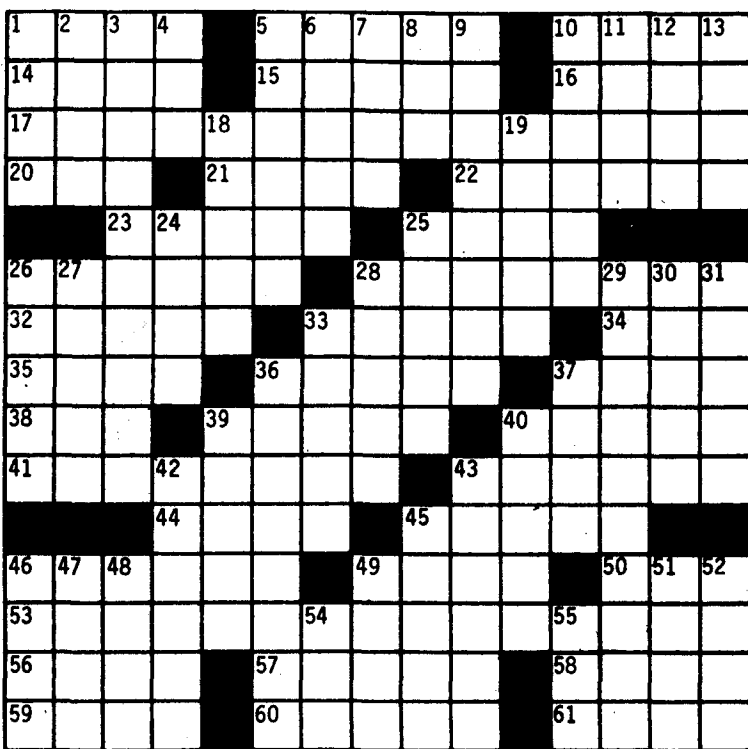

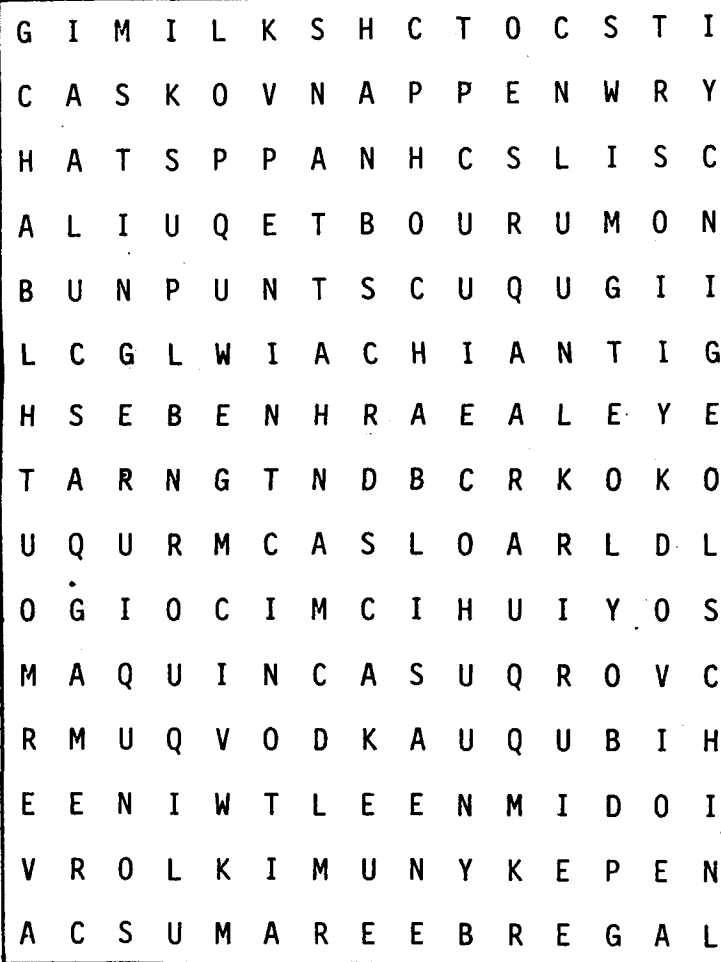

DRINKS FOR DRIVERS

WINNING TEA PUNCH

1/2 cup 100% instant tea
2 quarts water
1 6-oz. can frozen limeade
1 6-oz. can frozen lemonade
1 6-oz. can frozen pineapple juice concentrate
1 pint cranberry juice cocktail
In punch bowl, combine instant tea, water, concentrates and cranberry juice. Just before serving, add ice. Makes more than 1 gal. or 25 five-ounce servings.

HOT CRAN-APPLE CIDER

2 quarts apple cider
1 1/2 quarts cranberry cocktail
1/4 cup brown sugar
3-inch cinnamon sticks
1 1/2 teaspoons whole cloves
Heat to boiling; reduce heat and simmer 15 to 20 minutes. Strain. 25 servings (about 1/2 cup each.)
