VEHICLE REGISTRATION

The fee-based vehicle registration program provides for the enhancement and maintenance of walkways, roadways, and parking facilities at Penn State Harrisburg. All vehicles must be registered to park on campus. You may register in person at the Business Services Office, Room 116 Olmsted Building, or request a mail-in registration form by calling (717) 948-6006.

Hours:

Monday and Thursday
8 am - 6 pm
Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday
8 am - 5 pm

All students must pay these fees to register vehicles:

- 12 or more credits - \$40/semester
- 1-11 credit hour - \$20/semester

Residential students may purchase a restricted residential permit for parking only in residential lots at a lower rate.

Exceptions: Vehicle registration will be required for students who will be on campus Saturdays for classes. Students who display a current permit from the Milton S. Hershey Medical Center or any other Penn State campus where fees are charged do not have to register their vehicle.

Failure to register your vehicle by January 31, 1996, will result in a Traffic Violation Notice in the amount of \$15.00.
