mentors, according to Malm. The criteria is leadership, accomplishment, and professionalism.

The students are able to call the mentors and "get a feel for them," said Malm. If things go well, then a match has been made. If not, the student can then select someone else.

After the match, the students have an orientation session to attend. This allows them to get the most from the mentor-mentee relationship, said Malm. There is also a "kickoff" breakfast for them to get to know each other.

After the breakfast, students should have contact with their mentor at least five times from

October to April. This might mean going to the job site or just discussing current issues in the field.

At the end of the year, there is a "Wrap-up" reception and evaluation to complete, Malm says.

Some students have been lucky in the past to be offered jobs or internships, he added. Former student participants have been known to come back and say "Wow!" Malm said.

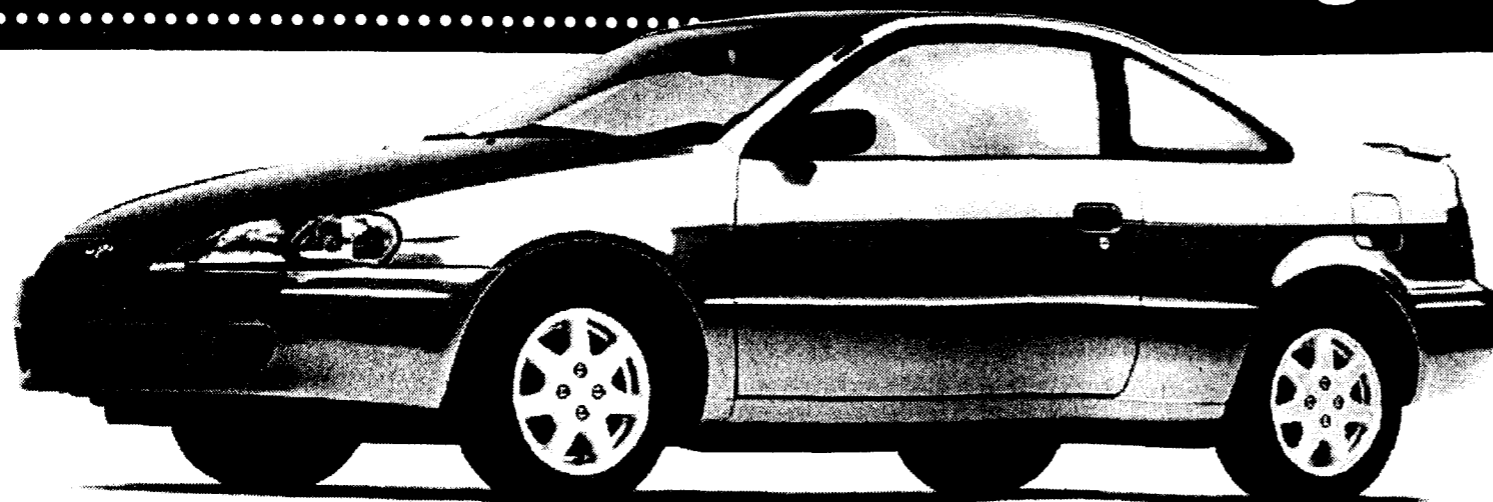
