

- C) May not serve on committees under the SGA unless mentioned in this constitution or bylaws.

Article VI - Elections, Appointments, Tenure, and Qualifications

Section 1

Executive Board and Senior Senators

- A) Elections shall be held in the spring semester and handled by the election screening committee.
- B) Their term of office shall be from the last SGA meeting in the spring semester to the last meeting the following year.
- C) Must be a registered student, not be on disciplinary probation, and must be in good standing with the University to qualify and remain in office.
- D) Must take the oath of office to begin their term.

Section 2

Graduate and Junior Senators

- A) Elections shall be held in the fall semester and handled by the election screening committee.
- B) Their term of office shall be from the time of their election and swearing in to the last meeting of the spring semester in the same academic year.
- C) Must be a registered student, not be on disciplinary probation, and must be in good standing with the University to qualify and remain in office.
- D) Must take the oath of office to begin their term.

Section 3

Associate Justices and Chief Justice

- A) Shall be appointed by the President of SGA, and confirmed by two thirds majority vote of the Senate.
- B) Their term shall run from the moment they take the oath of office to the day they graduate, are removed, or resign.
- C) Must be registered students, not be on disciplinary probation and must be in good standing with the University to qualify and remain in office.
- D) Justices must take the oath of office to begin their term.
