all cultures. [The center should be] a place for all students to go for reflection."

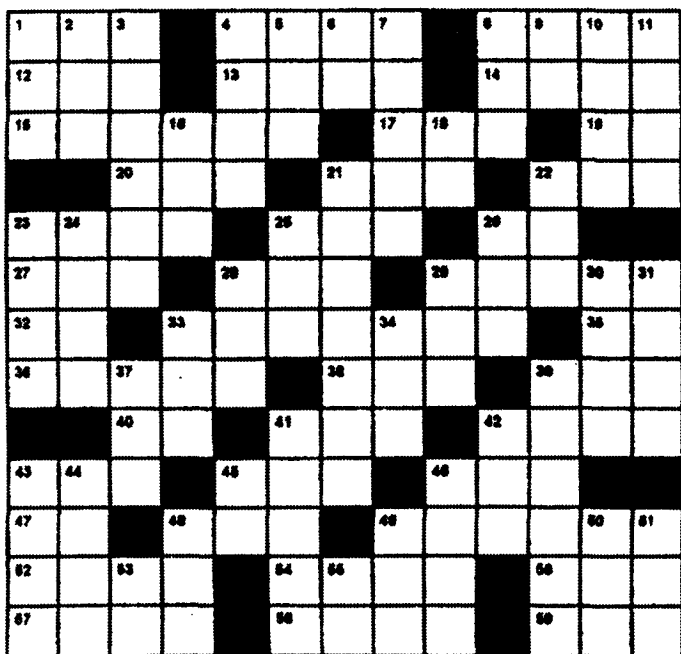
Dr. William Mahar, chair of the Humanities Department, said: "He always had a vision. He believed that the arts were an integral part of education. He was proud of his heritage, his people and his culture."

James Burton, a 1947 graduate of PSH and a former Black Student Union member, recalled LaGrone's dedication to education and the arts. He called on all students to "come together and talk about history as well as the future. It's time we move into the new millennium and embrace everyone."

After the unveiling of the bust, awards of appreciation were given out by Alma Wing, coordinator of the Minority Academic Excellence Program. PSH professors Dr. Clem Gilpin and Dr. Winston Richards received awards for their recognition and appreciation of vision. Following the ceremony, guests walked to the OLCAC for a ribbon cutting and refreshments.
