Find out who your academic advisor is and talk to that person. You may have to be persistent, but it's worth it.



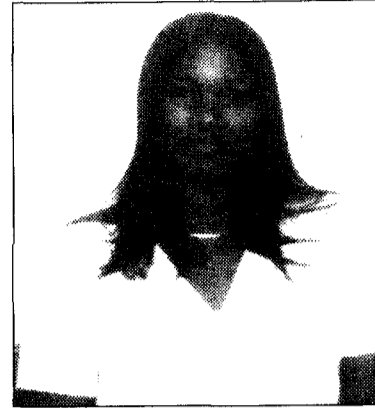

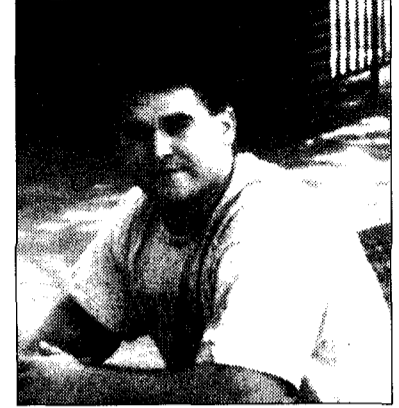

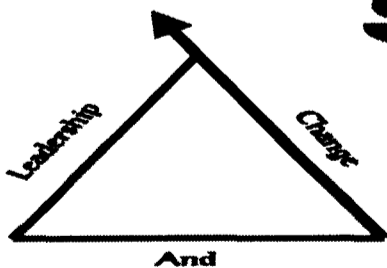
