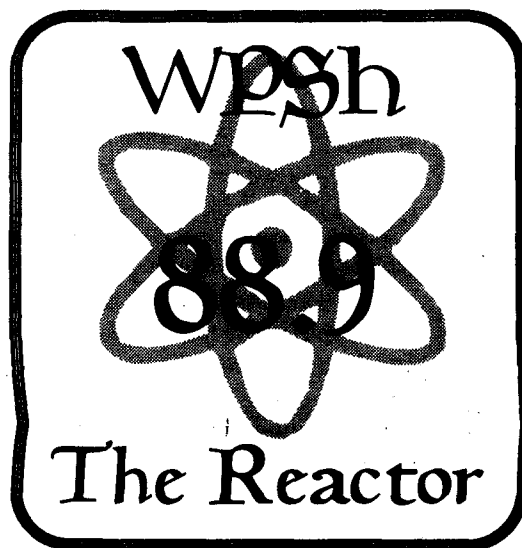
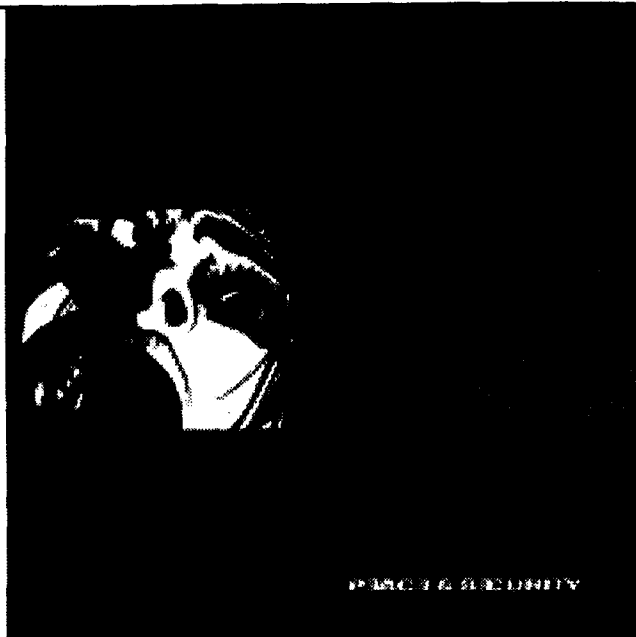

For fans of: Hatebreed, In Cold Blood, Blood for Blood's "Revenge on Society."



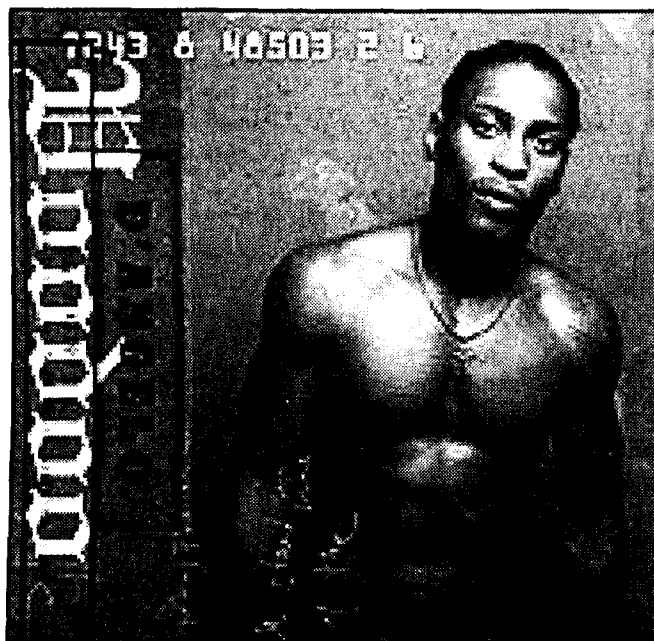
