

Earth Day Rainy But Not Miserable



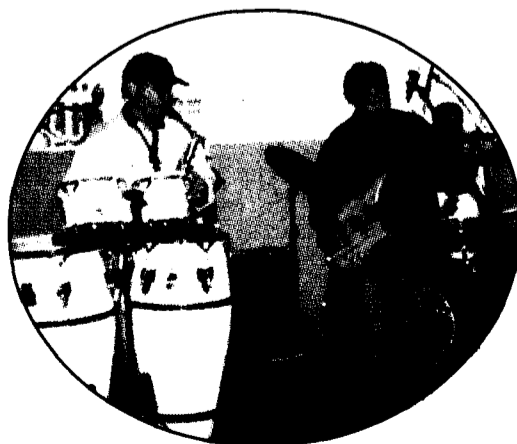
