Army of the Potomac.—After a retrograde movement which continued until this army was inside of Fairfax, having suffered considerable losses principally in cavalry, and inflicted probably no more than equal loss upon the enemy, except in capturing a battery of his artillery, suddenly we had the movement reversed, Lee retreating and made pursuing. This change occurred on Monday last week, Oct. 19th.

On Friday night the enemy constructed pontoon bridges, which they used to cross the Rappahannock near the Orange and Alexandria Railroad bridge, and the next morning a large portion of their infantry crossed and drove back Gregg's division of cavalry, and subsequently engaged with two brigades of our infantry, respectively of the 2d and 3d Corps.
