## HELMUT KAUTNER REINCARNATED

Appearing November 6, 1965 at 8 P. M. in Erie Hall will be Helmut Kautner's The Best Is Silence. Music by Bernhard Eichhorn. Photography by Igor Oberberg, starring Hardy Kruger, Tessa Van Eyck and Ingrid Andre.

Kautner uses "Malet" as his inspiration for an intriguing contemporary Freudian drama, set in Germany today. The central characters and plot have been retained although some modernization is noted in its presentation.

This film is particularly recommended for literature, drama, and German language classes.
