cease publication.

In contrast, students at Penn State's University Park Campus have chalked up a victory of sorts in last year's furor over undergraduate women not being permitted to visit the apartments of male students.

Revised regulations, approved by the Administrative Committee on Student Affairs, provide for a parental permission system to allow students to entertain in, and to be entertained in, apartments which are used as living quarters by students.

Changes in the names of two Colleges of the University were recently approved by the Board of Trustees to better reflect the work of the Colleges.

The College of Home Economics was designated the College of Human Development and the College of Mineral Industries was renamed the College of Earth and Mineral Sciences.

Applications for the November 18 and 19, 1966 administrations of the College Qualification Test are now available at Selective Service System local boards throughout the country.

Eligible students who intend to take this test should apply at once to the nearest Selective Service local board for an Application Card and a Bulletin of Information for the test.

Following instructions in the Bulletin, the student should fill out his application and mail it immediately in the envelope provided to SELECTIVE SERVICE EX-AMINING SECTION, Educational Testesting Service, P.O. Box 988, Princeton, New Jersey 08540. Applications for the test must be postmarked no later than midnight, October 21, 1966.

According to Educational Testing Service, which prepares and administers the College Qualification Test for the Selective Service System, it will be greatly to the student's advantage to file his application at once. Byregistering early, he stands the best chnace of? being assigned to the test center he has chosen. Because of the possibility that he may be assigned to either of the testing dates, it is very important that he list a center and center number for each date on which he will be available to take the test.
