CUBS SET RECORD IN WINNING

The Behrend Campus Basketball team, Tuesday night defeated the Venango Campus of Clarion by a score of 121 to 91. In this game an all time single game scoring record was broken. The old record of 115 points was set against the Du Bois Campus in the 62-63 season.

Joe Williams was high scorer for the Cubs with 31 points, while pulling down 32 rebounds. Tom Taylor had his best night ever with 22 points. Behrend's attack was well balanced, having six players in double figures. Besides Williams and Taylor, McGregor, Hornyak, Etzel, and Dylewski were the other players in double figures.

Behrend's high scoring output symbolized the sharp offense displayed. The Cubs scored 40 points in the first 11 minutes of the game, and exceeded 100 with 8 minutes still remaining on the clock.

Before this article is published, the team will have played two more games. Two home games are scheduled for this week, Tuesday, December 6, against Ashtabula Campus of Kent State and Saturday, December 10, against Johnstown Campus of Pitt.

The Johnstown game will be the first league game and will tell who will host the state tournament this year.

LEARNING CENTER

be followed in a few months by a two-story residence hall unit to house 200 students.

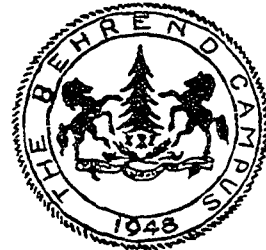
This will be the tenth major building under construction at Penn State's branch campuses so far this year.
