Do you think a Boosters Club for athletic events is necessary? Why? Would you Join? Do you think Boosters have accomplished something this year?

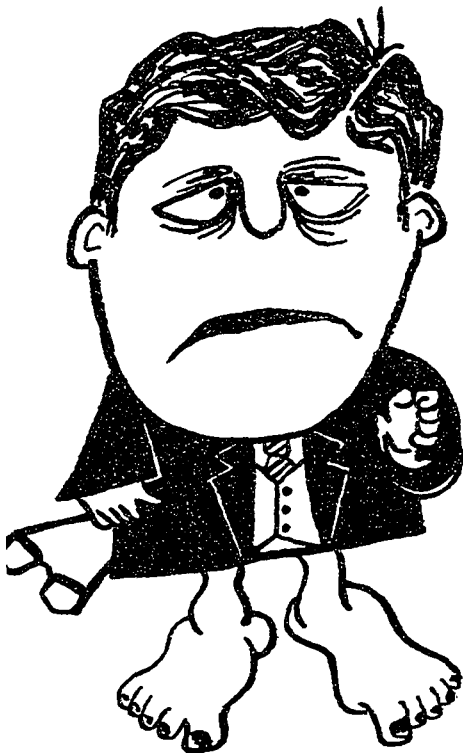
