## CAGERS RECORD NOW 6-2

BEHREND CUBS RESUME PLAY

After their long holiday break, the Behrend Cubs returned to the basket ball court Wednesday night beating Shenango Valley Campus of PSU 95-75. The Cubs attack was spearheaded by Doug Moorehead with 25 points, Howie McGregor, and new members to the squad Al Messina and Dan Fry.

Due to eligibility (all athletes must have at least a 1.7 accumulative average), Behrend has lost three of its players: Duane May, who was 8th leading scorer out of some 40 junior colleges in this region, Duane Edwards, who started at guard for four games while Howie McGregor was out with injuries, and Dan Griggs, who played in all seven games and was very instrumental in helping to win the Erie County Tech game. Together they average 136 points, and over twenty rebounds a game. Their loss will be deeply felt on the team, and as Coach Roger Sweeting said, "There's no way you can replace three players like these, who have been with the team for more than two months, and have been such a tremendous asset to the squad."

Although losing three players, the basketball team has added two more members for a twelve-man roster: Dan Fry, Al Messina. Fry, an ex-stalwart, and Messina, a standout at Academy, will both benefit the team with their experience on the basketball court.

Saturday afternoon, Behrend hosts the Altoona Campus team in Erie Hall. Next week, the Cubs hit the road for two away games: Tuesday, January 16, at Jamestown Community College, and next Saturday, January 19, against the New Kensington Campus. Coach Sweeting asks the support of the students for the Altoona game, and also asks students interested in making the bus trips with the team for the away games to contact him. As the Coach put it "We are paying good money for these buses, and for our last two road games, there were empty seats on the bus. I feel we should have some real support from the students for their team."

### WRESTLING

The wrestling team opened their season at Lorain County Community College. The Cubs were shut out except for a lone victory by Ken Carpenter. Ken beat a former Ohio State High School champ 4-3. The rest of the team was pinned except for Al Dorchester at 167 who was defeated 12-3, and Dusty Kurtic who sustained injuries in the match and had to lose by default. The final score was 38-3.

The second match was against Allegheny Community College. The Cubs had three pins to their credit, scored by Ken Carpenter, Al Dorchester, and Bob Valenti. The score in this close match was 22-15.
