Classical Guitarist Peter Segal and coloratura soprano Deborah Cook will perform together in the RUB Lecture Hall, Friday, January 31. The program will begin at 8 p.m., and there is no charge for students. All others will be charged \$1.00 for admission.

Segal, who started studying guitar at seven, had studied with Jose Thomas (who was a prodigy of Andre Segovia) in Spain, and Peter Colonna, who has spent summers working with Segovia. Segal is presently a college student at Temple University but is also a teacher at Settlement Music

School, where he is the youngest member on the faculty.

Miss Cook, who debuted in a recital at Philadelphia's famed Academy of Music in 1965, is rapidly making a name for herself in the music world. Her florid singing of the Mad Scene from Lucia di Lammermoor earned the soprano a standing ovation.

The Philadelphia Inquirer said of Miss Cook that she has a "... pure, accurate voice that served her well through the showy role (Lucia) ... a technician of taste and musical solidarity."

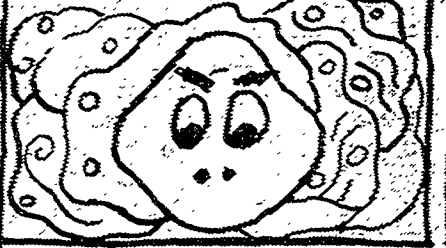
