Mr. Sotack will have a meeting Friday, March 13 with faculty members and society presidents to discuss the new budget terms.

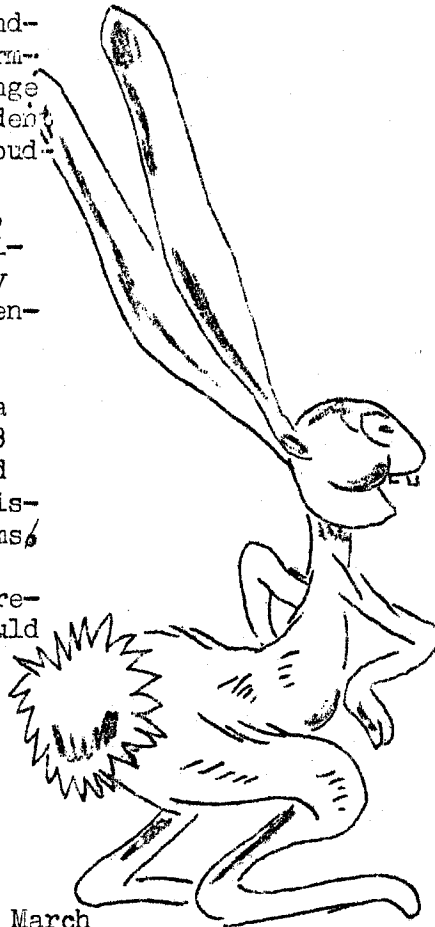
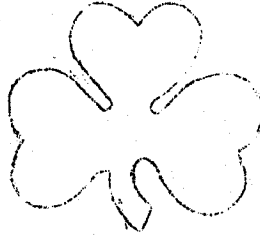
The council would appreciate it if students would attend this meeting and set forth new ideas for broadening the scope of Highacres.
