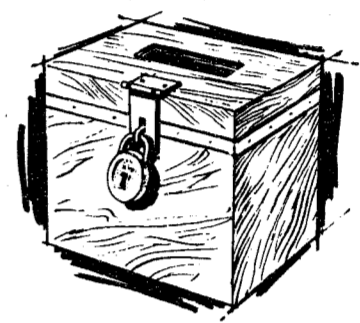

## 77 athletes earn letters

**UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa.**—A total of 77 athletes in six varsity sports earned letters during Penn State's 1970-71 winter sports season.

The list of letter-winners includes 15 members of the Lion wrestling team that tied for fourth in the 1971 NCAA championships at Auburn, Ala., and 17 members of the gymnastics team that was third nationally in the NCAA competition at Ann Arbor, Mich.

The gymnastics and wrestling teams each boasted an individual NCAA champion

this year. Andy Matter, a junior from Upper Darby, Pa., won the NCAA 167-pound wrestling championship; and Tom Dunn, a senior from Arlington Hts., Ill., was an individual winner on the parallel bars. Dunn also served as team captain for the gymnasts.
