The Fourth Annual Awards Banquet was held May 9, 1974, at Gus Genetti's Pennsylvania Room in Hazleton.

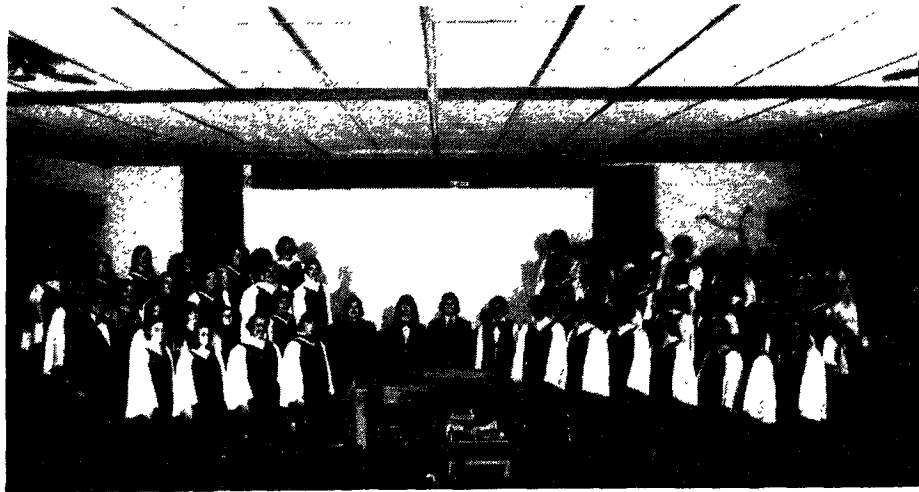
