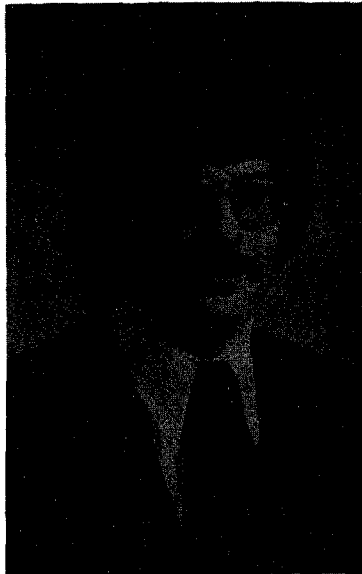


# ERIC WALKER AWARD
