### Faculty To Vote On Unionization Today

Faculty members at Penn State will vote on Wednesday and Thursday, March 30 lnd 31, to accept or reject representation by a union.

Polling sites will be established at each of the University's Campuses throughout the state; where eligible faculty members are located. The Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board will conduct the election.

Faculty members will have three choices on the ballot: The Pennsylvania State University Professional Association, The American Association of University Professors, and "No Representation."

If none of the options recieve a majority of the votes cast on the first ballot, a run-off election between the two options recieving the most votes will be conducted by the P.L.R.B. on Wednesday and Thursday, April 20 and 21.

## Library Losses High Says Ferry

520 books have been stolen from the Highacres Library in a two-year period according to Mary Ferry, Highacres Librarian. "It's a bad situation,"

"It's a bad situation," said Ferry.

The average cost of a library book is \$12. The cost of a science book is at least \$20. With processing that means that in a two-year period over \$8,000 worth of books have been stolen from the Library.

Ferry feels there is a viable solution to this problem. That solution involves the installation of an electromic detection system. This system would trigger an alarm any time a book was taken out of the Library. "Losses can be cut by 98% to 99%. " Ferry said, "The system could pay for itself by reducing the cost in stolen books." continued on page 7
