## Arts Festival Draws 9,000

The Greater Hazleton Fine Arts Festival

drew about 9,000 people
over the three day period, according to Mr.
Everitt Binns, Chairman
of the Creative Arts
Festival's House Committee. This year's Festival was the twelfth annual festival held by
