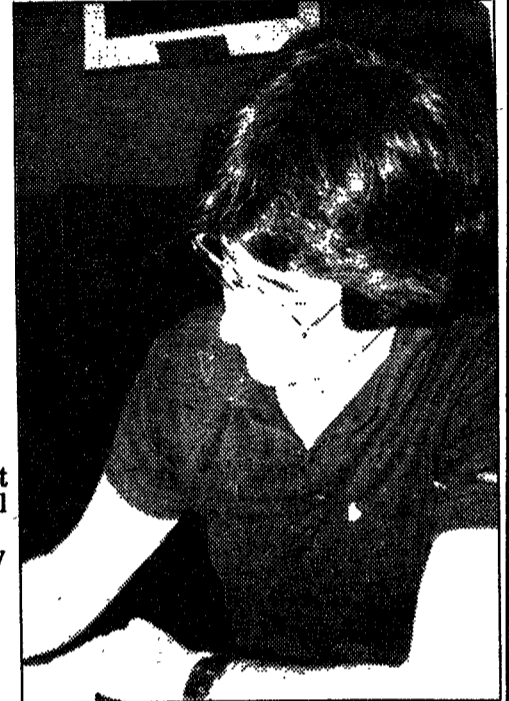

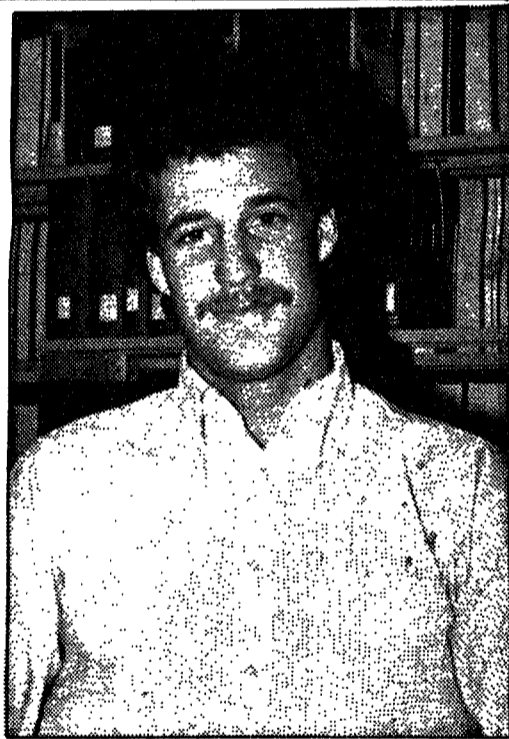
How much of an affect will the deep cuts in federal grants and loans to college students have on your ability to pay tuition costs or your educational plans?
