

Kentucky University annexed their second straight NCAA basketball championship on March 29 as they defeated Oklahoma A & M, 46-36.

With a throng of 12,500 thrilled onlookers witnessing the fray from the bleachers of the University of Washington's Edmundson Pavilion, Kentucky's 6'7" center, Alex Groza, unleashed a one-man attack that resulted in a triumph for the boys from the mountain state. Besides doing some superb ball -handling Groza hit the nets for 25 important counters. He left the game in the third quarter via the personal foul route. As a result of his commendable performance, Alex was voted by attending sportswriters the most valuable individual player in the playoffs.
