COUNCIL RECOMMENDS BASKETBALL COACH; PLANS HALLOWEEN PARTY

Student Council at its meeting Thursday afternoon in the Council office appointed a social chairman, recommended a basketball coach, and made plans for the release of the social calendar for the year, including a Halloween Party.

Council recommended the appointment of a ~~male~~ ~~man~~ as basketball coach for the 1952-53 season. The recommendation of a ~~male~~ ~~man~~ faculty member as coach was necessitated by the fact that physical education is not being offered at Highacres this term. 160 STUDENTS AT HIGHACRES; KOREAN GI'S STARTING TO COME IN

There are 160 students enrolled at Highacres, it is revealed by the latest analysis by assistant administrative head Frank C. Kostos. Broken down into various significant categories, the figures show that there are 139 men and 21 women enrolled in 8 different schools which have a total of 29 different curricula.

The School of the Liberal Arts leads the field with 64 enrolled. Following in size are Engineering 41; Chemistry and Physics 23; D.I.R. 10; Agriculture 9; Education 6; Home Economics 2; Mineral Industries 2; Specials 2; and Physical Education 1.

There are 95 first semester students, 7 second semester students, 54 third semester, and one fourth semester student. Included in the total enrollment are 22 veterans of service in the Armed Forces of the United States, most of them under P.L. 550, the so-called Korean GI Bill of Rights.
