The results of the election are not available for publication yet.

The five students from each class --- freshman and sophomore who received the most votes will be on the nominating list. Both the faculty and Parnassus can make additional nominations. Members of Parnassus are automatically nominated.

From the nominating list -- probably comprising about 20 names -- Parnassus will select the recipient of the awards by a system of voting against those who they feel are less qualified to receive the awards.
