## COUNCIL APPROVES BUDGET; STUDENT-FACULTY BOARD ACTS TODAY

Members of Student Council voted unanimously for the proposed budget at a special meeting Thursday at 5 o'clock. During the fifth period today, the Student-Faculty Board will meet to give their approval or disapproval of the budget. As

passed by Council the budget is as follows:

The money alloted for social activities will be used for the convocation dinner, three major dances (the Thanksgiving dance, the AFROTC Ball, and the May dance), the spring all-college picnic, and various parties. The exact amounts to be assigned for each event will be decided by the social committee, which is headed by Norm Hall and Jack Donovan.

The decision on basketball came after Student Council had conducted a survey among the members of the student body. Council voted unanimously for sponsoring a basketball team, which will cost almost a third of the proposed budget.

Response among the men concerned was sounded out when Mr. Peightal, the faculty director of athletics, called a meeting at which 17 men signed up for the team. Plans are now being made to get this extensive program underway.
