Vairo says the new firm will provide the design for the place and be responsible for hours of operation and pricing. He added that the contract will have a "closeable clause." If either the University or the vendor wishes to terminate, there must be thirty days advance notice given.

Vairo hopes to have a new company within one month.

Meanwhile, the catering service continues to serve students temporarily - amidst tables instead of counters. The Bureau of the Physically and Visually Handicapped, former operator of the service, was directed by the University to remove all of its equipment.

Vairo would like to express his thanks to the entire student body for its cooperation during the entire ordeal.

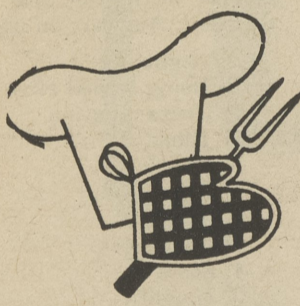
