United States is the brain child of Larry Gelbart, the creator of $\mathbf{M}^{*} \mathbf{A}^{*} \mathbf{S}^{*} \mathbf{H}^{*}$. How Gelbart could put together a series of consistantly high quality such as $\mathbf{M}^{*} \mathbf{A}^{*} \mathbf{S}^{*} \mathbf{H}^{*}$ and then follow that success with a mess like United States is hard to conceive. Nevertheless, he's managed to do just that.
