## **BA Instructor Barrett Wins Outstanding Teacher Award**

Richard T. Barrett, an Instructor in Business Administration, was named Penn State Delco's Outstanding Teacher of the Year for 1990-91 at the Honors Convocation in April.

When he announced the award, Dr. Edward Tomezsko, Campus Executive Officer, said Mr. Barrett "joins a long line of exceptional people who are firmly committed to the best ideals of this University." He hailed Barrett for "further building the campus tradition of excellence and for setting the standards for others to follow."
