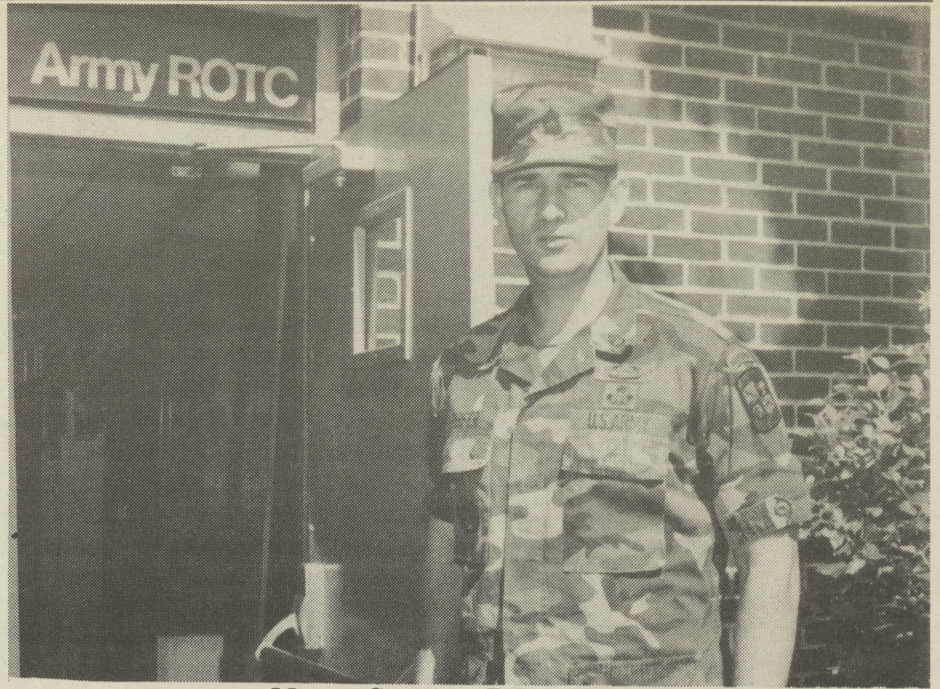

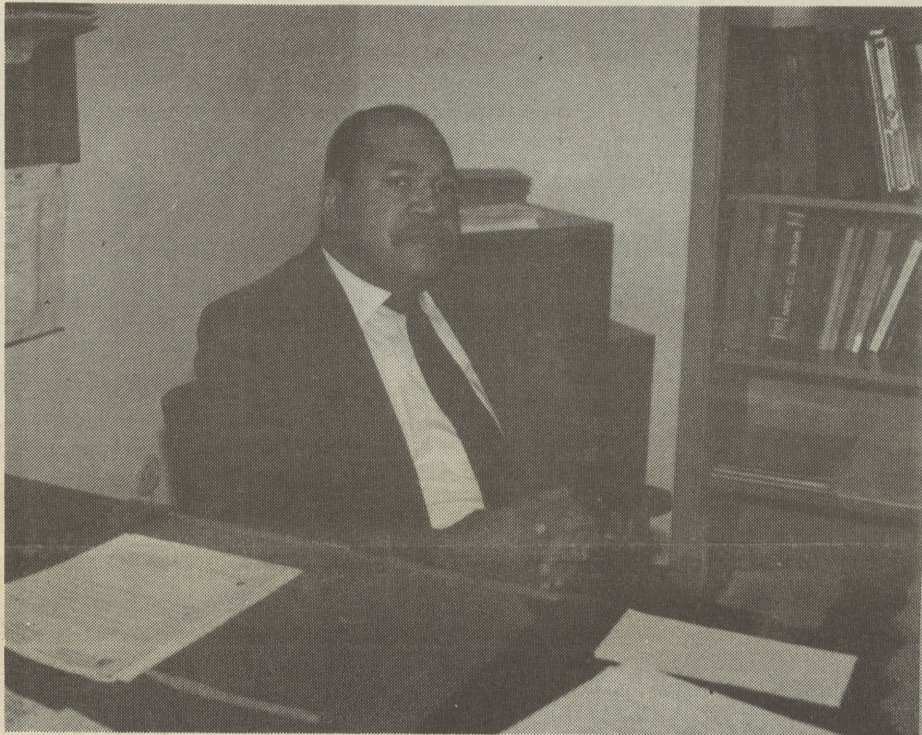
offered at Delco and, finds the "delight at dealing with numbers of students one can manage, hard to express!"
