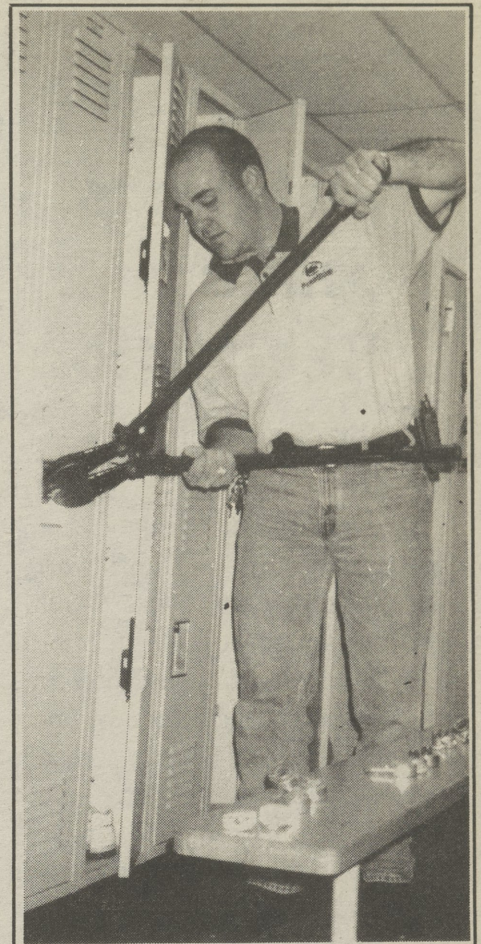

## Activities Fee Committee Reports '97-'98 Allocations

You may have noticed on your Fall semester bill that in addition to tuition you are paying two other costs: a Computer Fee and an Activity Fee. The latter is a \$31.00 per semester fee which will yield approximately \$90,000 for students to spend on co-curricular and extra-curricular activities at Penn State Delaware County during '98-'99.

How does that money get spent? A campus Allocation Committee reviews proposals by student clubs and organizations, academic classes, or individual students, faculty and staff at their meetings every two weeks, and votes to determine how the money will be allocated.

The Allocation Committee is made up of seven students (including the Student Government Association President) and two to three alternates, as well as three faculty/staff (including the Coordinator of Student Life). New members, especially freshmen, are needed. If you would like to help allocate \$90,000 this year, contact co-chairs SGA President Marty Ranalli (892-1240) or Coordinator of Student Life Barbara Daniel (892-1457) right away.

The first Allocation Committee meeting is Tuesday, September 8 at 4:00 PM in the Lion's Den.
