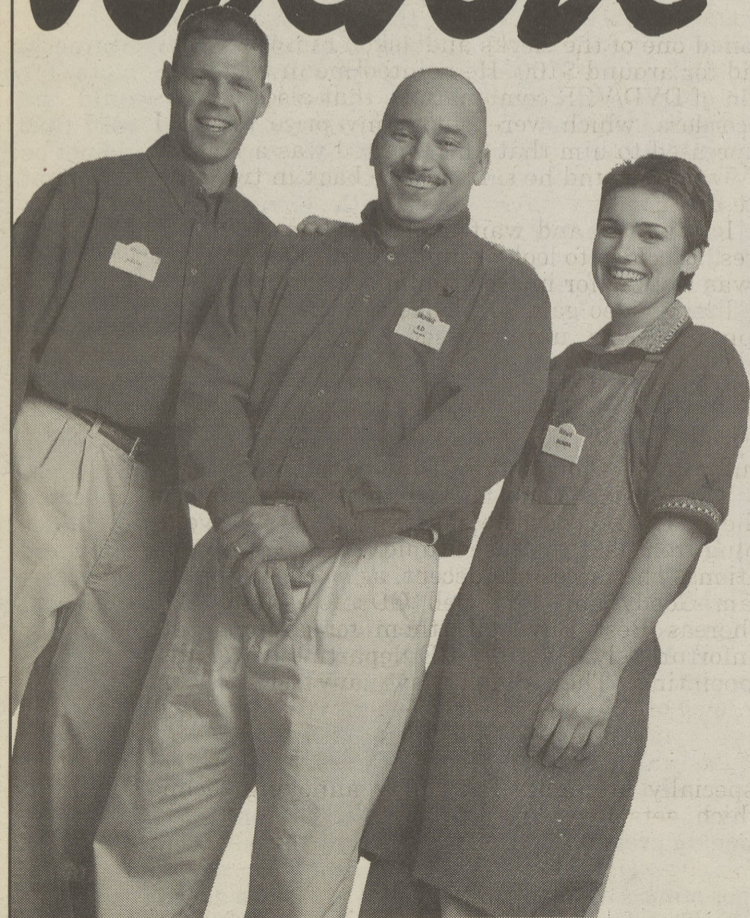
The book addresses the fundamental role heterosexuals play in supporting the rights of gay individuals.
