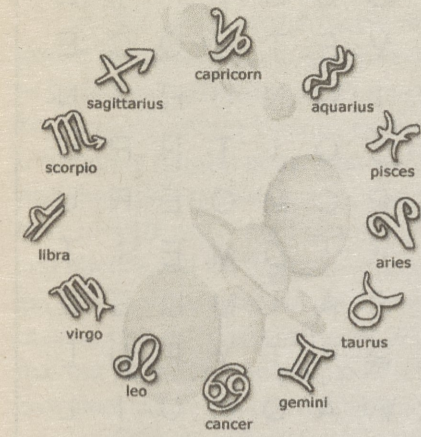

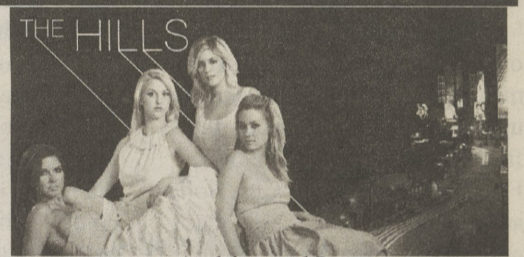
Dear Stressed Lil Mama-
