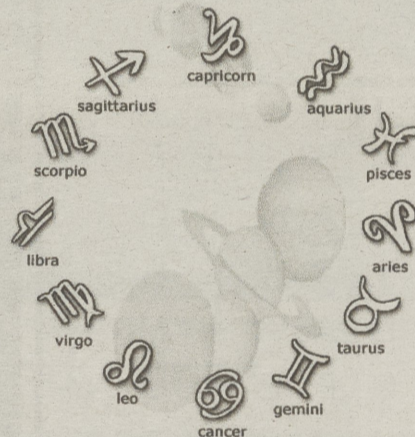
this winter.
