Hello To All

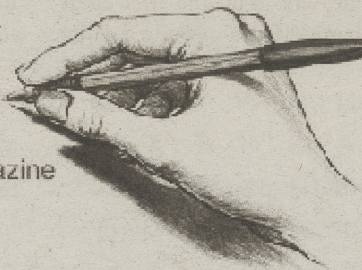
