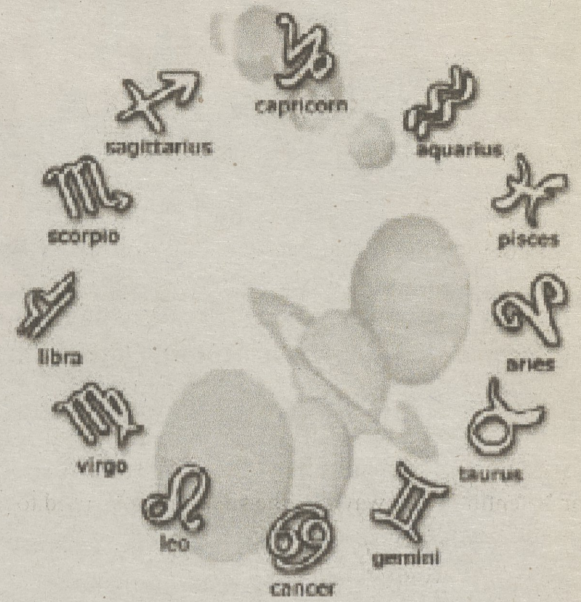

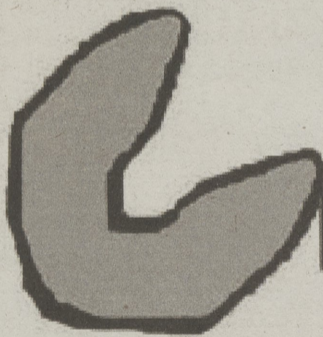
### Aquarius
