With the 1955 Southeastern District 4-H Baby Beef Show only recent history, Lancaster County youth in the Red Rose 4-Baby Beef Club are already making plans for next year's shows.

Saturday 132 members of the club received small steer calves at the New Holland Sales Stables, and during the coming year will feed them out and groom them for showing in the Southeastern District Show, perhaps the Eastern National in Timonium, Md., and possibly at the 1957 Pennsylvania Farm Show in Harrisburg.

M. M. Smith, Lancaster county agricultural extension agent, reports 64 youths drew Angus, 57 Herefords and 11 Shorthorns. The Black calves averaged 416 lbs, the Whites 432 lbs, the Reds and Roans 399 lbs

This year's total was only slightly below that of last year when 139 received calves
