registered Guernsey cow, Willow Bend's Ann, owned by John A. Breneman, Willow Street, Pa., has completed a production record of 10,942 lbs of milk and 598 lbs of fat, according to the American Guernsey Cattle Club.

This production, made in the AGCC's Herd Improvement Registry, is equal to 5,100 quarts of high-quality milk "Ann" was a six-year-old and was milked two times daily for 305 days while on test, and met calving requirements.
