## Youth Will Hold Limelight in 1956 State Farm Show

HATFISBURG, — Names of 25 high schools which have qualified to send teams to the 1956 Pennsylvania Farm Show for the annual competition in vocational agriculture demonstrations have been certified to the Farm Show Commission by H. C. Fetterolf, chief of agriculture education in the Department of Public Instruction.

Competing teams he said, will be limited to vocational agriculture pupils and cannot exceed four members. In most cases teams will be composed entirely of members of the Outure Farmers of America. On the stage of the Farm Show's auditorium they will depict improved methods of agriculture and farm management with demonstration topics ranging from production and marketing methods to cooperation of farmers, hunters, and the Game Commission.

The Farm Show Commission is offering \$300 in prizes to teams placing first to tenth, the top three awards being \$50, \$40 and \$35, and fourth to tenth prizes \$25 each. Judges will be R. W. Heim of the Delaware State Department of Public Instruction, H. M. McDonald State Supervisor of Agricultural Education, and R. C. S. Sulliff, chief of the New York Bureau of Agricultural Education. The demonstrations are scheduled for the first three days of the Farm Show.
